### MENTAL HEALTH PROBLEMS

- Depression
  - Symptoms
  - 7-16%
- Relationship Problems
  - Marital, Work, School
- Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD)
  - 1-14%
- Anxiety
  - Symptoms
  - 9-20%

#### BARRIERS TO CARE

- Why do some people not seek help?
  - Differences in language and culture?
  - Poorer quality of care?
    - Misdiagnosis often occurs
  - Shame and loss of face
  - Lack of Understanding
  - \$\$\$

## MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT PROVIDERS

- Therapist/Counselor/ Psychologist
- "Clinical" Social Workers
- Psychiatrists

## SUGGESTIONS WHEN MEETING PROVIDERS

- O How much per session? Is the first session free?
- Sliding scale? Co-Pay? Insurance?
- Type of treatment preferred/Approach of talk therapy
  - CBT
  - Psychoanalytical
  - Family therapy
- 1st Session: Clarify goals, treatment plan
- Policy for missed appointments

### CODE OF ETHICS

- Confidentiality and privacy
  - Access to records
  - Parents/children
- Consent to treatment
